STANDARD AWARD CRITERIA

Standard criteria have been established for scholarships and bursaries to ensure fair and equitable selection. Unless the award details state otherwise, selection is based first on the standard criteria, then secondary requirements; awards are available to Canadian citizens or permanent residents and international students who are in at least their second year of full-time studies at NWP.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are awards given based on academic excellence. The standard criteria for this type of award are:

- Full-time student in fall and winter semester
- Selection based on grade point average (GPA)

- Students must be registered full-time at Northwestern Polytechnic.
- Submit only one copy of this application form.
- The Awards Committee will not consider incomplete applications or applications where all awards have been checked off.
- Please check only those awards for which you believe you may qualify.
